Q1.	A culture has initially 1.0×10^4 bacterial cells in 200 mL of media. The bacteria has a generation time of 20 minutes. The culture was incubated for 60 minutes. Calculate: a) How many generations occurred during the incubation period? b) What is the final concentration (cells/mL) c) If you plate 0.10 mL of the culture (no dilution) on an agar plate, how many colonies do you expect? Q2.	Correct the following Wrong Statements and Give reasons for your answer: a. Optical Density measurements provide accurate count of viable cells in an inoculum. b. 'Pour plate technique' can be used for counting the number of microbes in a biological sample. c. Packaged spices, meat, microbiological plastic ware and medical supplies are sterilized by X-rays. d. Acidic food is more prone to be spoiled by bacteria than fungi.	[1.5 X 4=6]
